
## Estonian education system

A brief overview of our system



### **Estonian education in numbers**

- **1,3 million** people
- 510 general education schools
- 30 vocational education institutions
- 13 higher education institutions

## **Adult Education Act (1993-2015-2025)**

### 1993

1st Adult

### 2015

New AEA clarified continuing education regulations

### 2020

Universities introduced the concept of micro-degree in continuing education

### 2021

Study on implementing micro-credential Stakeholder discussions, insight Draft amendment

to AEA prepared

### 2025

April 1st, renewed AEA entered into force

September 1st, microcredentials entered into force

## Scope of Adult Education Act and Standard (2025)

- 1. Management and development of area of adult education
- 2. Requirements for Management of Continuing Education Institutions
- 3. Provision of Continuing Education and Disclosure of Information
- 4. Learner's Right to Study Leave
- 5. Organization of Financing of Continuing Education
- 6. State and Administrative Supervision
- Establishes the requirements for continuing education curricula,
- The requirements for documents issued regarding participation in or completion of continuing education,
- List of curriculum groups for continuing education (ISCED-F 2013).

### Estonian legal background for micro-credentials

### **Adult Education Act (TäKS)**

- Micro-credential means the set of acquired, certified and recognised knowledge and skills in continuing education that corresponds to the needs of the labour market or the society.
  - Institutions of professional higher education and universities (hereinafter institutions of higher education) may name micro-credential a micro-degree if the subjects of the level of higher education make at least one-half of the volume of micro-degree curriculum.
- Sets the necessary requirements for conducting micro-credential studies including the necessity of passing the quality assessment in specific curriculum group.

### **The Standard of Continuing Education**

Sets the requirements for curricula and documentation.


## <u>Conditions and procedures for curriculum group based quality assessment of continuing education institution</u>

- Sets the premise of what needs to be assessed during the quality assessment
- Sets that the assessment is conducted by the Estonian Quality Agency for Education (HAKA), an independent body within the Education and Youth Board.



# Lifelong Learning has become a lifestyle in Estonia

Estonians within the 25-64 age group actively participate in learning at almost **double** the rate of the EU average -

21% vs 12%, Eurostat 2022


## **Estonian micro-credentials**

Micro-credentials are regulated by the law: Adult Education Act and Standard

- Study volume 5-30 ECTS (130-780 h), 1 ECTS=26h
- CE courses, all kind of formats, no limitations
- HEI and VET and Private providers
- Universities using the term "micro-degree" and "micro-credentials"
- VET and private using the term "micro-credentials"
- Private providers using the term "micro-credentials"

## Micro-credentials in Estonian HEI

- Not a new concept
- Open University courses, continuing education,
   LLL courses decades of experience
- Institutional accreditation model: standard for Service to Society
- About 300 Micro Degree programs annually
- 4-year experience on the market







in curricula groups where provider has teaching right (assessed IA)

HEI can use term micro-degree for courses, at least 50% of degree subjects.

Registration of curricula of micro-credential

## Curriculum group-based quality assessment

- For continuing education providers who wish to start offering micro-credential training
- For formal education institutions (HEI and VET) that do not have the right to teach in a particular curriculum group where they wish to offer microcredential training







## **Application process**

Quality assessment is done by Estonian Quality Agency for Education (HAKA).

### **Process:**

- Provider self analyses
- Expert panels assessment

After positive results they have right to apply to register of micro-credentials.



## **Statistics (11.2025)**

### Micro-Credential Study Programmes registrations in Estonia (EHIS)



- By institution type:
  - Higher education institutions: 267
  - Vocational education institutions: 15
- Of which:
  - Micro-degree programmes: 230
- Curriculum groups:
  - Management and administration 37
  - Teacher training with subject specialisation 35
  - Software and applications development and analysis 16
  - Environmental sciences 4
  - Environmental protecting technology 3

### MC status 2025-26

### May-August 2025

**Higer Education** institutions and **vocational education** actively **register** (in EHIS) micro-degree and micro-credential courses

### September 2025

Initial providers (HEI and VET institutions) begin offering official microcredentials, 300+ courses are registered in EHIS

### **August-October 2025**

First private training providers are quality assessed by Quaity Agency (HAKA)

### Beyond 2026

Expansion of MC courses across Estonian education and training sector

#### 2026

State is building IT solutions for applying process (EHIS) and e-sertificates
