Improving access to higher education through microcredentials

The National Recovery Plan of the Czech Republic - Specific Goal C1

The project aims to improve the accessibility of higher education thanks to micro-credentials and the digitalization of activities related to the support of educational activities and administrative tasks associated with the study agenda. It is a joint project of 26 public universities. Their cooperation ensures mutual compatibility of solutions in the field of micro-credentials and digitisation of related activities. At the same time, this cooperation has a positive impact on the economy, efficiency and effectiveness of the funds used.

Project outputs

The project partners analysed the current state of various documents regarding skill-enhancing education on the national level and analysed practices from abroad in order to find the best solutions. It also focused on the development of a methodology for the recognition of existing courses or programmes that could fulfil the requirements for microcredentials, the design of a single unified certificate format and a methodology for unifying short-term education forms through the ECTS credit system.

The digitalization of the addressed area requires the creation of a joint on-line course catalogue for public universities that meet the requirements for micro-credentials and the development of unified information system for higher education results verification.


